Steps

- 1) Connect lower horizontal extrusions [4-7] between vertical extrusions [1-3] as shown.
- 2) Slide infills between vertical extrusions as shown.
- 3) Connect upper horizontal extrusions [4-7] between vertical extrusions [1-3] and on top of inserts.
- 4) Hang door from hinges on vertical [3].
- 5) Velcro shelf supports inside assembled base and place shelf on top of shelf supports.
- 6) Place counter top on assembled pedestal.

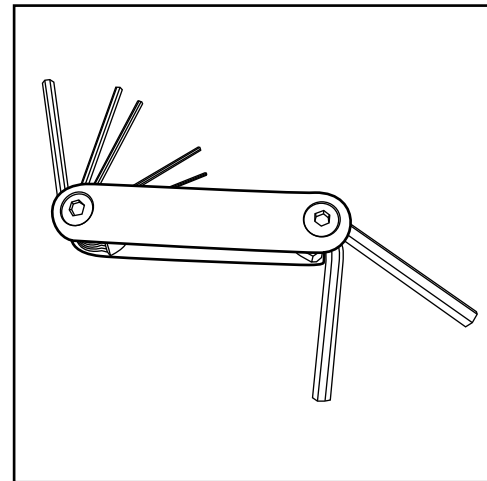
- Read entire setup instruction manual prior to unpacking parts and pieces.

Cleaning & Packing

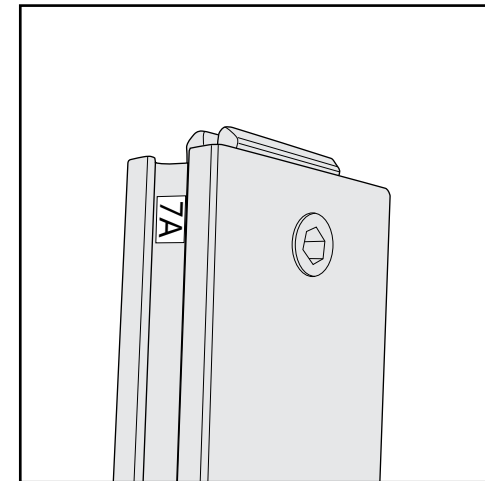
- For Cleaning Metal, Plex, & Laminate Parts: Use a **MILD NON-ABRASIVE** cleanser and soft cloth/paper towel to clean all surfaces.
- Keep exhibit components away from heat and prolonged sun exposure.
Heat and UV exposure will warp and fade components.
- Retain all provided Packing Materials. All provided packing materials are for ease of repacking & component protection.

Disassembly

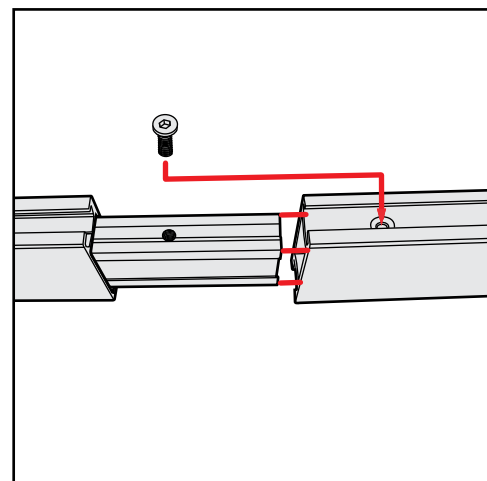
- For loss prevention, tighten all set screws and locks during disassembly.



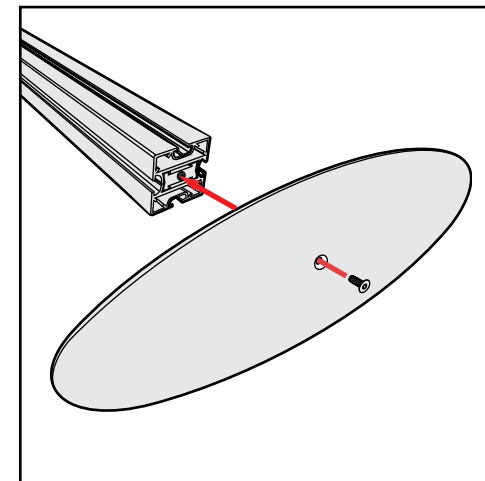
Hex Tool - Essential for Assembly



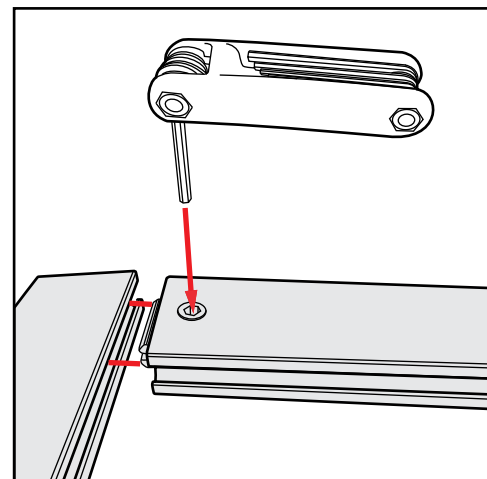
Part Identification - Numbering



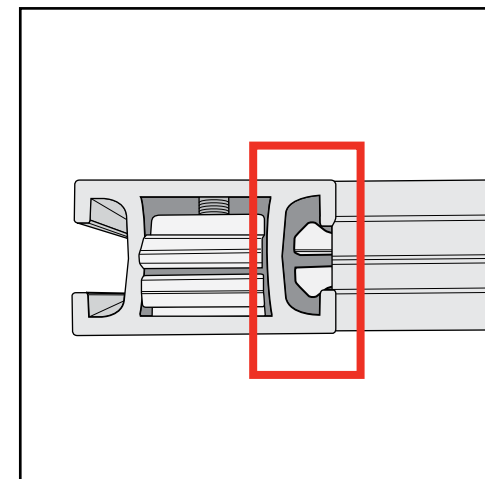
Spline Connection

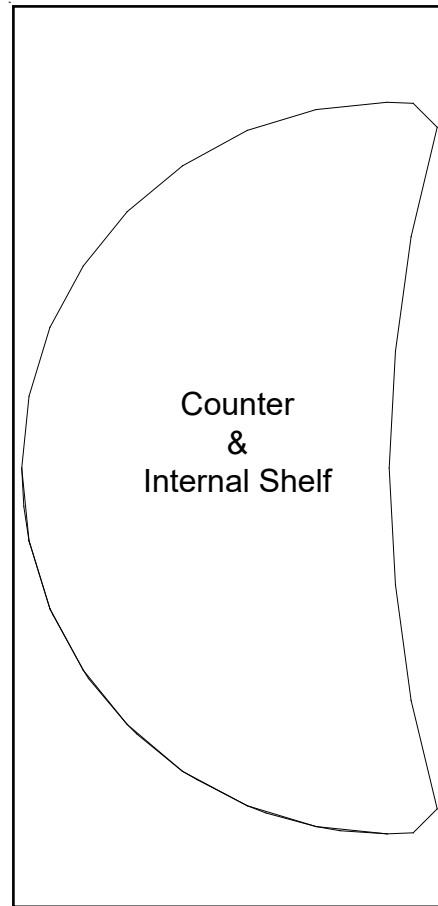

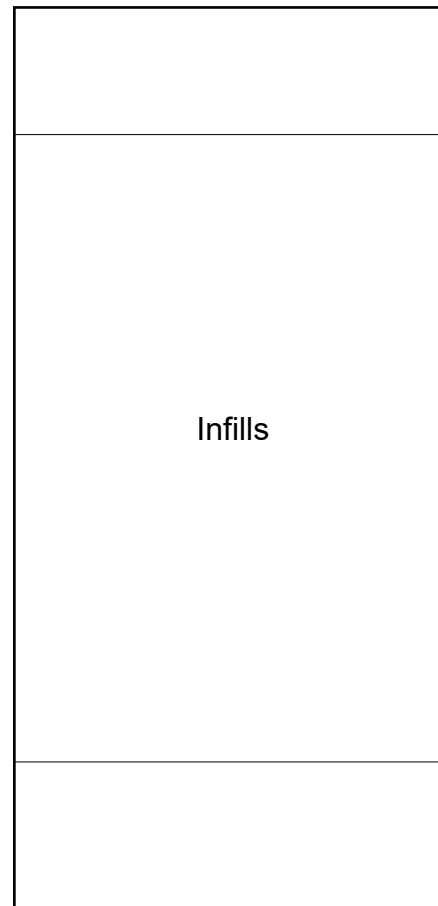

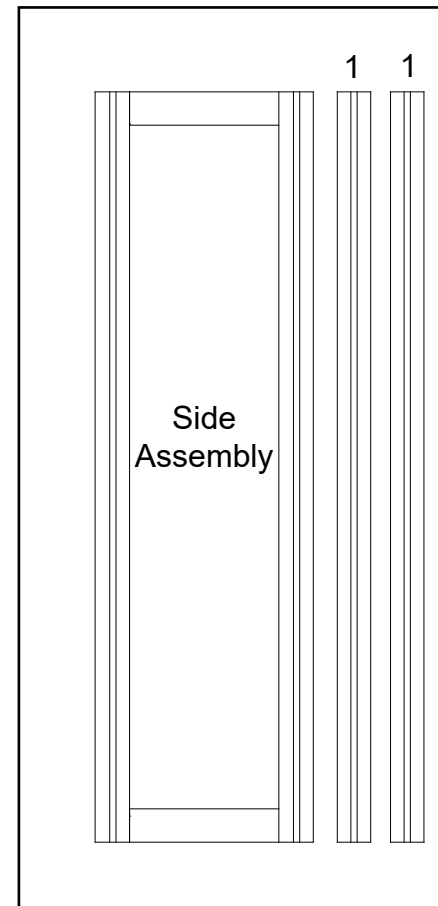
Top View of Each Level



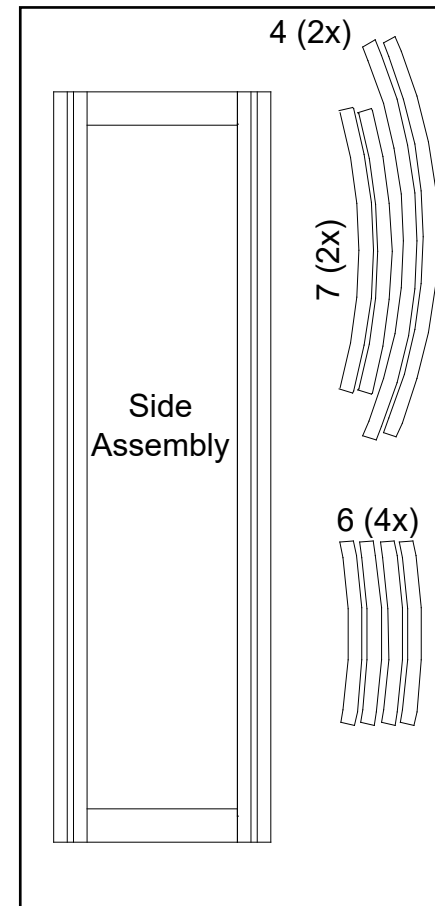

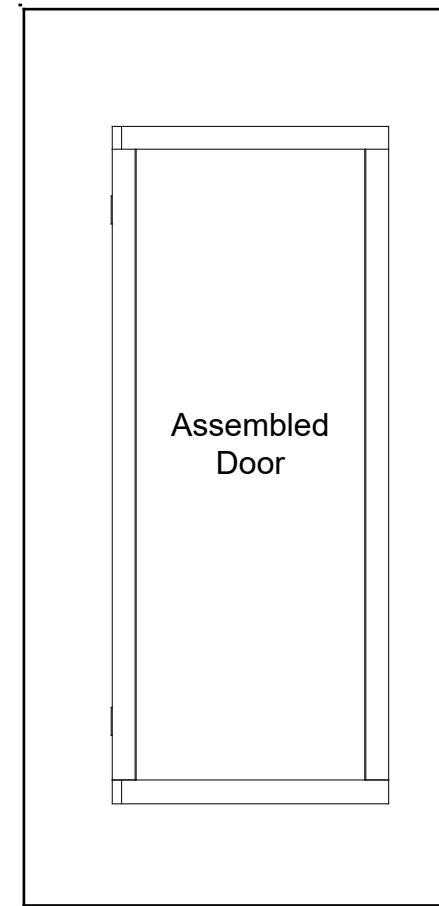
